

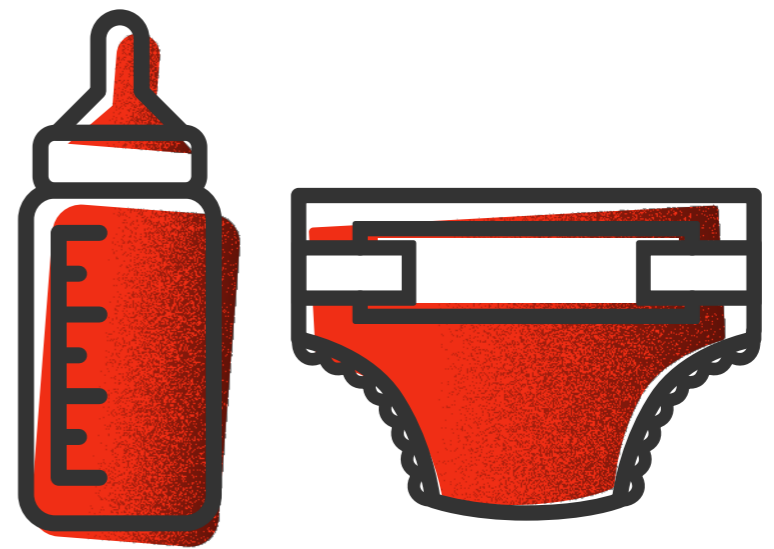

HOW TO **MAKE YOUR BABY** **LOOK CUTER** IN PHOTOS

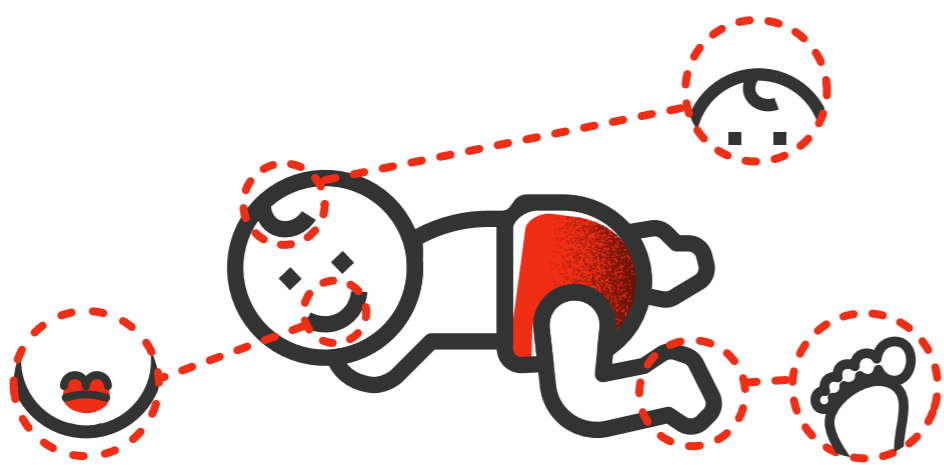
TIMING IS IMPORTANT

One way to prolong the photoshoot time is to **keep your baby well-fed, and make sure he/she has his/her bowels cleared.** In this way, your baby is comfortable and sleepy, which is what you will want in a baby photoshoot.



CAPTURE THE DETAILS

If your baby is awake, capture the innocence and purity by getting a close shot of his/her eyes with a macro lens.



Also, get close ups of the baby's toes, little bits of hair, or that cute, pouty mouth. Funny gestures or tickling the baby will help you get more expressions from him/her, which is more fun to shoot.



FIND THE RIGHT ANGLE

Instead of standing above your baby, **get to his/her level, lie on your belly if you must,** to capture the subject from his/her angle. In this way, the photo will reveal more details and you are also able to get more personal with your baby.

MAKE USE OF PROPS

Props are a great part of expressing your vision. Find something that tells a story – **a blanket knitted by your mother, a family heirloom, the soft toy that you're intending to pass down to your little one...** Make sure that everything in the photo is meaningful and has a piece of history.
