### TOP 10 ON THE PHOTOGRAPHER'S CHECKLIST

1

#### GET TO KNOW THE COUPLE

Getting them to open up will improve the overall experience.

#### UNDERSTAND THEIR PHOTOGRAPHY STYLE

Every shot should express who they are.

#### KNOW WHO'S INVITED

Get your hands on the guest list, if possible. Make sure everyone gets in the shot.

Consists of wedding sequence, important moments to capture and any other special requests from the couple.

The more, the better the variety to choose from.

Makes editing a lot better.

Stay active, out of the way, but always there for the perfect shot.

Look smart, act the part, dress like a professional.

Don't start solo. Pair up to cover angles and capture more precious moments.
